## **Philippians 1:6-14**

**6 Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ:**

**7 Even as it is meet for me to think this of you all, because I have you in my heart; inasmuch as both in my bonds, and in the defence and confirmation of the gospel, ye all are partakers of my grace.**

**8 For God is my record, how greatly I long after you all in the bowels of Jesus Christ.**

**9 And this I pray, that your love may abound yet more and more in knowledge and in all judgment;**

## **Philippians 1:6-14 - continued**

**10 That ye may approve things that are excellent; that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ.**

**11 Being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, unto the glory and praise of God.**

**12 But I would ye should understand, brethren, that the things which happened unto me have fallen out rather unto the furtherance of the gospel;**

**13 So that my bonds in Christ are manifest in all the palace, and in all other places;**

**14 And many of the brethren in the Lord, waxing confident by my bonds, are much more bold to speak the word without fear.**

## **Exodus 3:1-4**

**1 Now Moses kept the flock of Jethro his father in law, the priest of Midian: and he led the flock to the backside of the desert, and came to the mountain of God, even to Horeb.**

**2 And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush: and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed.**

**3 And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt.**

**4 And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, Here am I.**

**2 Kings 20:1-6**

**1 In those days was Hezekiah sick unto death. And the prophet Isaiah the son of Amoz came to him, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Set thine house in order; for thou shalt die, and not live.**

**2 Then he turned his face to the wall, and prayed unto the LORD, saying,**

**3 I beseech thee, O LORD, remember now how I have walked before thee in truth and with a perfect heart, and have done that which is good in thy sight. And Hezekiah wept sore.**



## **II. We Need To Change Our Attitude When God Speaks**

**2 Kings 20:1-6 - continued**

**4 And it came to pass, afore Isaiah was gone out into the middle court, that the word of the LORD came to him, saying,**

**5 Turn again, and tell Hezekiah the captain of my people, Thus saith the LORD, the God of David thy father, I have heard thy prayer, I have seen thy tears: behold, I will heal thee: on the third day thou shalt go up unto the house of the LORD.**

**6 And I will add unto thy days fifteen years; and I will deliver thee and this city out of the hand of the king of Assyria; and I will defend this city for mine own sake, and for my servant David's sake.**

**The Lord is my strength and my shield; my heart trusted in him, and I am helped: therefore my heart greatly rejoiceth; and with my song will I praise him.**

**Acts 11:19-21**

**19 Now they which were scattered abroad upon the persecution that arose about Stephen travelled as far as Phenice, and Cyprus, and Antioch, preaching the word to none but unto the Jews only.**

**20 And some of them were men of Cyprus and Cyrene, which, when they were come to Antioch, spake unto the Grecians, preaching the LORD Jesus.**

**21 And the hand of the Lord was with them: and a great number believed, and turned unto the Lord.**

**14 But and if ye suffer for righteousness' sake, happy are ye: and be not afraid of their terror, neither be troubled;**
