Luke 8:40-41

40 And it came to pass, that, when Jesus was returned, the people gladly received him: for they were all waiting for him.

41 And, behold, there came a man named Jairus, and he was a ruler of the synagogue: and he fell down at Jesus' feet, and besought him that he would come into his house:

and I will give you rest.**

John 6:37

II. Jairus Demonstrated The Greatest Example of A Father

Luke 8:42

**For he had one only daughter, about twelve years of age,
and she lay a dying. But as he went the people thronged
him.**

A. He came to talk to Jesus about his child

B. The most privileged children in the world

1. Those whose parents pray for them

**2. Those whose names are often before the throne of
grace**

C. The most underprivileged children

1. Those who grow up in godless homes

2. Those whose parents do not pray for them

D. We can pray for our children and expect answers

Matthew 18:10

Take heed that ye despise not one of these little ones; for I say unto you, That in heaven their angels do always behold the face of my Father which is in heaven.

1 John 5:14-15

14 And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us:

15 And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.

James 5:13-16

13 Is any among you afflicted? let him pray. Is any merry? let him sing psalms.

14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

15 And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

16 Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

III. Jairus Faced The Greatest Test Of A Father's Faith

Luke 8:49-50

49 While he yet spake, there cometh one from the ruler of the synagogue's house, saying to him, Thy daughter is dead; trouble not the Master.

50 But when Jesus heard it, he answered him, saying, Fear not: believe only, and she shall be made whole.

A. When he awaits news of his child's welfare

B. When the news came it was bad

C. Encouragement comes from Jesus in the presence of bad news

Nothing takes Jesus by surprise

1. The healing of the woman along the way

Luke 8:43-48

2. Walking with Jesus allows us to encounter faith building opportunities

Psalm 37:4-5

4 Delight thyself also in the LORD: and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart.

5 Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass.

Luke 8:51-56

51 And when he came into the house, he suffered no man to go in, save Peter, and James, and John, and the father and the mother of the maiden.

52 And all wept, and bewailed her: but he said, Weep not; she is not dead, but sleepeth.

IV. Jairus Found The Power Of God

A. The daughter of this great father was healed

Luke 8:51-56 - continued

53 And they laughed him to scorn, knowing that she was dead.

54 And he put them all out, and took her by the hand, and called, saying, Maid, arise.

55 And her spirit came again, and she arose straightway: and he commanded to give her meat.

56 And her parents were astonished: but he charged them that they should tell no man what was done.
