- a. The one caught stumbling in a trespass**
- b. By one who has evidence of a spiritual walk**
- c. To “set” the one who fell on the right path**
- d. In true humility**

2. Respect the hurting (6:2)

- a. To endure with someone**

- b. To love as Christ**

Galatians 6:11

Ye see how large a letter I have written unto you with mine own hand.

A. Others saw his involvement

B. Others were impacted by his involvement

C. Involvement takes effort

II. Will Reveal The Inner Motivations (6:12-16)

A. Of the Judaizers (6:12-13)

1. To avoid persecution (v 12)

Galatians 6:12

As many as desire to make a fair shew in the flesh, they constrain you to be circumcised; only lest they should suffer persecution for the cross of Christ.

2. To look good (v 13)

Galatians 6:13

For neither they themselves who are circumcised keep the law; but desire to have you circumcised, that they may glory in your flesh.



For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision, but a new creature.

C. Of others' walk (6:16)

Galatians 6:16

And as many as walk according to this rule, peace be on them, and mercy, and upon the Israel of God.

1. A single rule

Acts 2:46

And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart,

2. A significant result

3. A sign of relationship with God

Galatians 6:17-18

17 From henceforth let no man trouble me: for I bear in my body the **marks of the Lord Jesus.**

B. Marks = stigmata

2 Corinthians 11:23-27

23 Are they ministers of Christ? (I speak as a fool) I am more; in labours more abundant, in stripes above measure, in prisons more frequent, in deaths oft.

24 Of the Jews five times received I forty stripes save one.

25 Thrice was I beaten with rods, once was I stoned, thrice I suffered shipwreck, a night and a day I have been in the deep;

26 In journeyings often, in perils of waters, in perils of robbers, in perils by mine own countrymen, in perils by the heathen, in perils in the city, in perils in the wilderness, in perils in the sea, in perils among false brethren;

27 In weariness and painfulness, in watchings often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness.
