
God Wants Us To See What He Sees

Zechariah 5:1-3

1 Then I turned, and lifted up mine eyes, and looked, and behold a flying roll.

2 And he said unto me, What seest thou? And I answered, I see a flying roll; the length thereof is twenty cubits, and the breadth thereof ten cubits.

3 Then said he unto me, This is the curse that goeth forth over the face of the whole earth: for every one that stealeth shall be cut off as on this side according to it; and every one that sweareth shall be cut off as on that side according to it.



We Need To Know That God Is Looking

Mark 11:11

**And Jesus entered into Jerusalem, and into the temple:
and when he had looked round about upon all things,
and now the eventide was come, he went out unto
Bethany with the twelve.**

- **Where Jesus looked**
- **What Jesus looked at**
- **Who was looking with Him**

We Need To Understand That God Is Looking

Psalm 14:2

The LORD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, and seek God.

Galatians 6:3

For if a man think himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceiveth himself.

I. Do We See The Same Heart That God Sees?

A. A sinful heart?

Jeremiah 17:9

The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?

B. A self-righteous heart?

Luke 16:15

And he said unto them, Ye are they which justify yourselves before men; but God knoweth your hearts: for that which is highly esteemed among men is abomination in the sight of God.

I. Do We See The Same Heart That God Sees?

C. A searching heart?

Jeremiah 29:13

And ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart.

D. A sanctified heart?

Ezekiel 18:31

Cast away from you all your transgressions, whereby ye have transgressed; and make you a new heart and a new spirit: for why will ye die, O house of Israel?

II. Do We See The Same Church That God Sees?

A. That brings the wrath of God

Mark 11:15-17

15 And they come to Jerusalem: and Jesus went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves;

16 And would not suffer that any man should carry any vessel through the temple.

17 And he taught, saying unto them, Is it not written, My house shall be called of all nations the house of prayer? but ye have made it a den of thieves.

II. Do We See The Same Church That God Sees?

B. That brings a warning from God

Revelation 3:17-19

17 Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:

18 I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

19 As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent.

II. Do We See The Same Church That God Sees?

C. That brings the welcome of God

Revelation 3:8-10

8 I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name.

9 Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and worship before thy feet, and to know that I have loved thee.

10 Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth.

II. Do We See The Same Church That God Sees?

D. Do we see a need to see things God's way?

1 Peter 4:17

For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?

III. Do We See The Same Opportunities That God Sees?

John 4:35

Say not ye, There are yet four months, and then cometh harvest? behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest.

- A. Stop looking at your feet**
- B. Start looking where the need exists**
- C. Stay looking until the work is done**
