Psalm 119:49-56

Hope shines brightest in the darkness

Psalm 119:49-56

ZAIN (ZAYIN)

49 Remember the word unto thy servant, upon which thou hast caused me to hope.

50 This is my comfort in my affliction: for thy word hath quickened me.

51 The proud have had me greatly in derision: yet have I not declined from thy law.

52 I remembered thy judgments of old, O LORD; and have comforted myself.

53 Horror hath taken hold upon me because of the wicked that forsake thy law.

54 Thy statutes have been my songs in the house of my pilgrimage.

Psalm 119:49-56 - continued

**55 I have remembered thy name, O LORD, in the night,
and have kept thy law.**

56 This I had, because I kept thy precepts.

I. Remember God's Promises (119:49-51)

A. They bring confidence from God (119:49)

Nehemiah 9:32

Now therefore, our God, the great, the mighty, and the terrible God, who keepest covenant and mercy, let not all the trouble seem little before thee, that hath come upon us, on our kings, on our princes, and on our priests, and on our prophets, and on our fathers, and on all thy people, since the time of the kings of Assyria unto this day.

B. They create confidence in God (119:49)

I wait for the LORD, my soul doth wait, and in his word do I hope.

C. They bring comfort in affliction (119:50)

2 Corinthians 1:3-4

3 Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort;

4 Who comforteth us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort them which are in any trouble, by the comfort wherewith we ourselves are comforted of God.
