Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,

B. Adoption possible because of redemption on the cross

C. God is developing you into what you ought to be Romans 8:23

And not only they, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body.
