



James 1:18-27

18 Of his own will begat he us with the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures.19 Wherefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath:

- **20** For the wrath of man worketh not the righteousness of God.
- 21 Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.

James 1:18-27 - continued

- 22 But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.
- 23 For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass:
 24 For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was.
 25 But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.

James 1:18-27 - continued

26 If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's religion is vain.

27 Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world.

I. We Are Reborn By His Truth (v 18)

- A. Consistent with His will 2 Peter 3:9
- The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to usward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.
- **B.** Created by His Word
- C. Consecrated by His Word John 17:17 Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.

II. We Are Restrained By His Truth (vv 19-25)

A. In anger (1:19-20)

1. Slow down (v 19)

Ephesians 4:31

Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:

2. Sin not (v 20)
Ephesians 4:26-27
26 Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath:
27 Neither give place to the devil.

II. We Are Restrained By His Truth (vv 19-25)

B. In activity (1:21-25)

- The Word should work in our lives (vv 21-22)

 a. Our preparation required (v 21)
 b. Our persistence required (v 22)
- 2. The Word should be witnessed in our lives (vv 23-24)
 - a. By careful attention (v 23)
 - **b.** By constant remembrance (v 24)

3. The Word should be wanted in our lives (v 25)a. By careful inspectionb. By continued intimacy

III. We Are Righteous By His Truth (vv 26-27)

- A. In language (1:26) Luke 6:45-46
- 45 A good man out of the good treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is evil: for of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaketh.
- 46 And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?

III. We Are Righteous By His Truth (vv 26-27)

B. In labor (19:27)

- 1. That is pure
- **1 Peter 1:22**

Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, *see that ye* love one another with a pure heart fervently:

2. That is purposeful

Matthew 25:36

Naked, and ye clothed me: I was sick, and ye visited me: I was in prison, and ye came unto me.

III. We Are Righteous By His Truth (vv 26-27)

B. In labor (19:27)

- **3. That is proper**
- 2 Peter 3:14

Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in peace, without spot, and blameless.
