I. The Assessments Of The Empty Tomb (20:1-10)

A. By Mary Magdalene (20:1-2)

John 20:1-2

1 The first day of the week cometh Mary Magdalene early, when it was yet dark, unto the sepulchre, and seeth the stone taken away from the sepulchre.

2 Then she runneth, and cometh to Simon Peter, and to the other disciple, whom Jesus loved, and saith unto them, They have taken away the LORD out of the sepulchre, and we know not where they have laid him.

I. The Assessments Of The Empty Tomb (20:1-10)

A. By Mary Magdalene (20:1-2)

1. Her reasons (v 1)

a. Restored by Christ

Luke 8:1-2

1 And it came to pass afterward, that he went throughout every city and village, preaching and shewing the glad tidings of the kingdom of God: and the twelve were with him,

2 And certain women, which had been healed of evil spirits and infirmities, Mary called Magdalene, out of whom went seven devils,

B. By Peter and John (vv 3-10)

1. The footrace to the tomb (vv 3-4)

John 20:3-4

3 Peter therefore went forth, and that other disciple, and came to the sepulchre.

4 So they ran both together: and the other disciple did outrun Peter, and came first to the sepulchre.

I. The Assessments Of The Empty Tomb (20:1-10)

B. By Peter and John (vv 3-10) - continued

2. The finding of John (v 5)

John 20:5

And he stooping down, and looking in, saw the linen clothes lying; yet went he not in.

3. The finding of Peter (vv 6-7)

John 20:6-7

6 Then cometh Simon Peter following him, and went into the sepulchre, and seeth the linen clothes lie,

7 And the napkin, that was about his head, not lying with the linen clothes, but wrapped together in a place by itself.

B. By Peter and John (vv 3-10) - continued

4. The follow-up by John (vv 8-9)

John 20:8-9

8 Then went in also that other disciple, which came first to the sepulchre, and he saw, and believed.

9 For as yet they knew not the scripture, that he must rise again from the dead.

Psalm 16:10

For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.

B. By Peter and John (vv 3-10) - continued

5. The finality of their investigation (v 10)

John 20:10

Then the disciples went away again unto their own home.

II. The Appearance Of The Eternal Christ (20:11-17)

C. Her greeting (20:12-17)

1. From the angels (vv 12-13)

John 20:12-13

12 And seeth two angels in white sitting, the one at the head, and the other at the feet, where the body of Jesus had lain.

13 And they say unto her, Woman, why weepest thou? She saith unto them, Because they have taken away my LORD, and I know not where they have laid him.

2. From Jesus (vv 14-17)

a. Unknown at first (vv 14-15)

John 20:14-15

14 And when she had thus said, she turned herself back, and saw Jesus standing, and knew not that it was Jesus.

15 Jesus saith unto her, Woman, why weepest thou?

whom seekest thou? She, supposing him to be the

gardener, saith unto him, Sir, if thou have borne him

hence, tell me where thou hast laid him, and I will take

him away.

b. Understood when her name was called (v 16)

John 20:16

Jesus saith unto her, Mary. She turned herself, and saith unto him, Rabboni; which is to say, Master.

2. From Jesus (vv 14-17) - continued

c. Unique (v 17)

John 20:17

Jesus saith unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father: but go to my brethren, and say unto them, I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; and to my God, and your God.

III. The Actions of The Encouraged Mary (20:18)

John 20:18

Mary Magdalene came and told the disciples that she had seen the LORD, and that he had spoken these things unto her.

III The Actions of The Encouraged Mary (20:18)

A. She went

Luke 7:22

Then Jesus answering said unto them, Go your way, and tell John what things ye have seen and heard; how that the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, to the poor the gospel is preached.

B. She witnessed

1 John 1:3

That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have fellowship with us: and truly our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ.

Testify Of The Living Christ

Mark 16:6

**And he saith unto them, Be not affrighted: Ye seek Jesus
of Nazareth, which was
crucified: he is risen; he is not here: behold the place
where they laid him.**
