- 24 Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy,
- 25 To the only wise God our Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen.

#### Introduction

#### **Psalm 150**

- 1 Praise ye the LORD. Praise God in his sanctuary: praise him in the firmament of his power.
- 2 Praise him for his mighty acts: praise him according to his excellent greatness.
- 3 Praise him with the sound of the trumpet: praise him with the psaltery and harp.
- 4 Praise him with the timbrel and dance: praise him with stringed instruments and organs.
- 5 Praise him upon the loud cymbals: praise him upon the high sounding cymbals.
- 6 Let every thing that hath breath praise the LORD. Praise ye the LORD.

- B. We need to respond to the call to adoration and praise
- C. Jude reminds us of three reasons to praise God

- A. We need keeping from falling in these areas
  - 1. Error of doctrine

**Matthew 15:9** 

But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.

- A. We need keeping from falling in these areas cont'd
  - 2. Error of spirit
    - a. Lack of love
    - b. Lack of discernment
    - c. Lack of belief
    - d. Lack of credibility
    - e. Lack of humility

#### **Psalm 51:10**

Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.

A. We need keeping from falling in these areas – cont'd 3. Outward sin

**Psalm 66:18** 

If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear me:

- A. We need keeping from falling in these areas cont'd4. Neglect of duty
- 1 Corinthians 4:2

Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful.

**James 4:17** 

Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.

- A. We need keeping from falling in these areas cont'd 5. Backsliding
- 2 Peter 1:8-9
- 8 For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 9 But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

- B. None but the Lord can keep us from falling
  - 1. We cannot keep ourselves without him

**Romans 7:18** 

For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but how to perform that which is good I find not.

- B. None but the Lord can keep us from falling cont'd2. No place guarantees security
- **Ezekiel 8:7-10**
- 7 And he brought me to the door of the court; and when I looked, behold a hole in the wall.
- 8 Then said he unto me, Son of man, dig now in the wall: and when I had digged in the wall, behold a door.
- 9 And he said unto me, Go in, and behold the wicked abominations that they do here.
- 10 So I went in and saw; and behold every form of creeping things, and abominable beasts, and all the idols of the house of Israel, pourtrayed upon the wall round about.

- B. None but the Lord can keep us from falling cont'd 3. No rules and regulations will work
- **Colossians 2:20-23**
- 20 Wherefore if ye be dead with Christ from the rudiments of the world, why, as though living in the world, are ye subject to ordinances,
- 21 (Touch not; taste not; handle not;
- 22 Which all are to perish with the using;) after the commandments and doctrines of men?
- 23 Which things have indeed a shew of wisdom in will worship, and humility, and neglecting of the body: not in any honour to the satisfying of the flesh.

- B. None but the Lord can keep us from falling cont'd
- 4. No experience can eradicate or protect us from evil Matthew 6:13

And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.

- C. The Lord can do it ....
  - 1. He is "able to keep,"
  - 2. He is "the only wise God, our Savior."
  - 3. He teaches us so that we do not sins by ignorance
  - 4. He warns us by giving us example
- 1 Corinthians 10:11

Now all these things happened unto them for examples: and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come.

- C. The Lord can do it cont'd
  - 5. By providence or affliction which remove occasions of sinning.
  - 6. By a bitter sense of sin

**Romans 7:13** 

Was then that which is good made death unto me? God forbid. But sin, that it might appear sin, working death in me by that which is good; that sin by the commandment might become exceeding sinful.

- C. The Lord can do it cont'd
  - 7. By his Holy Spirit, renewing desires for holiness.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:17
- For God hath not called us unto uncleanness, but unto holiness.
- D. The Lord will do it
- Philippians 1:6
- Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ:

# II. Let Us Praise Him Who Will Present Us Faultless

- A. None can stand in before God covered in fault Matthew 7:23
- And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.
- B. None can deliver us from fault but the Savior himself Romans 7:24-25
- 24 O wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me from the body of this death? I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- 25 So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin.

# II. Let Us Praise Him Who Will Present Us Faultless

C. Our Savior is divinely wise to sanctify

Ephesians 5:26

That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,

D. Our Savior will do it

John 14:13-15

- 13 And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.
- 14 If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.
- 15 If ye love me, keep my commandments.
- E. He will do it "with exceeding joy," to himself and to us

# III. Let Us Praise Him With Highest Attributes Of Praise

- A. Our praise is by Jesus, who is himself our Lord
- B. We want Him to ....
  - 1. To have "glory and majesty, dominion and power"
  - 2. Have these "now"
  - 3. Have these forever
- C. We affirm our praise
  - 1. With "exceeding joy"
  - 2. With "Amen"
